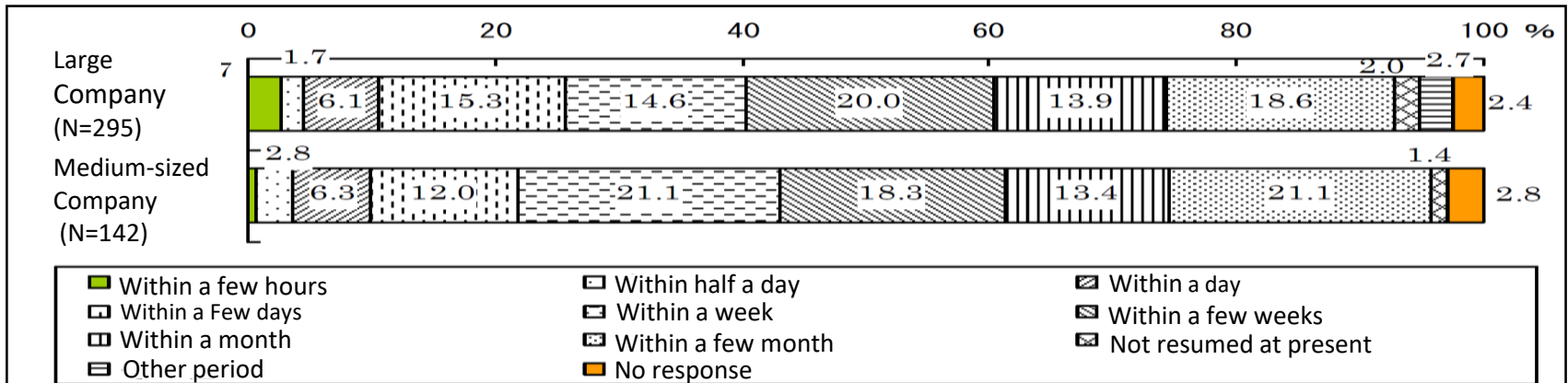
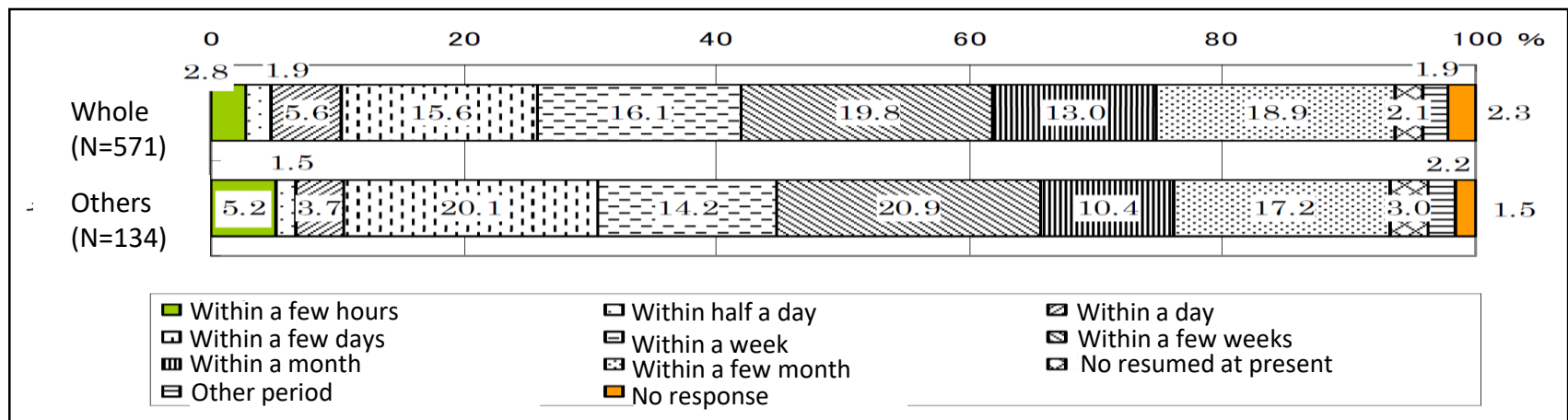


# The Time Necessary to Resume the Critical Operation after the Great East Japan Earthquake (as of November, 2011)
