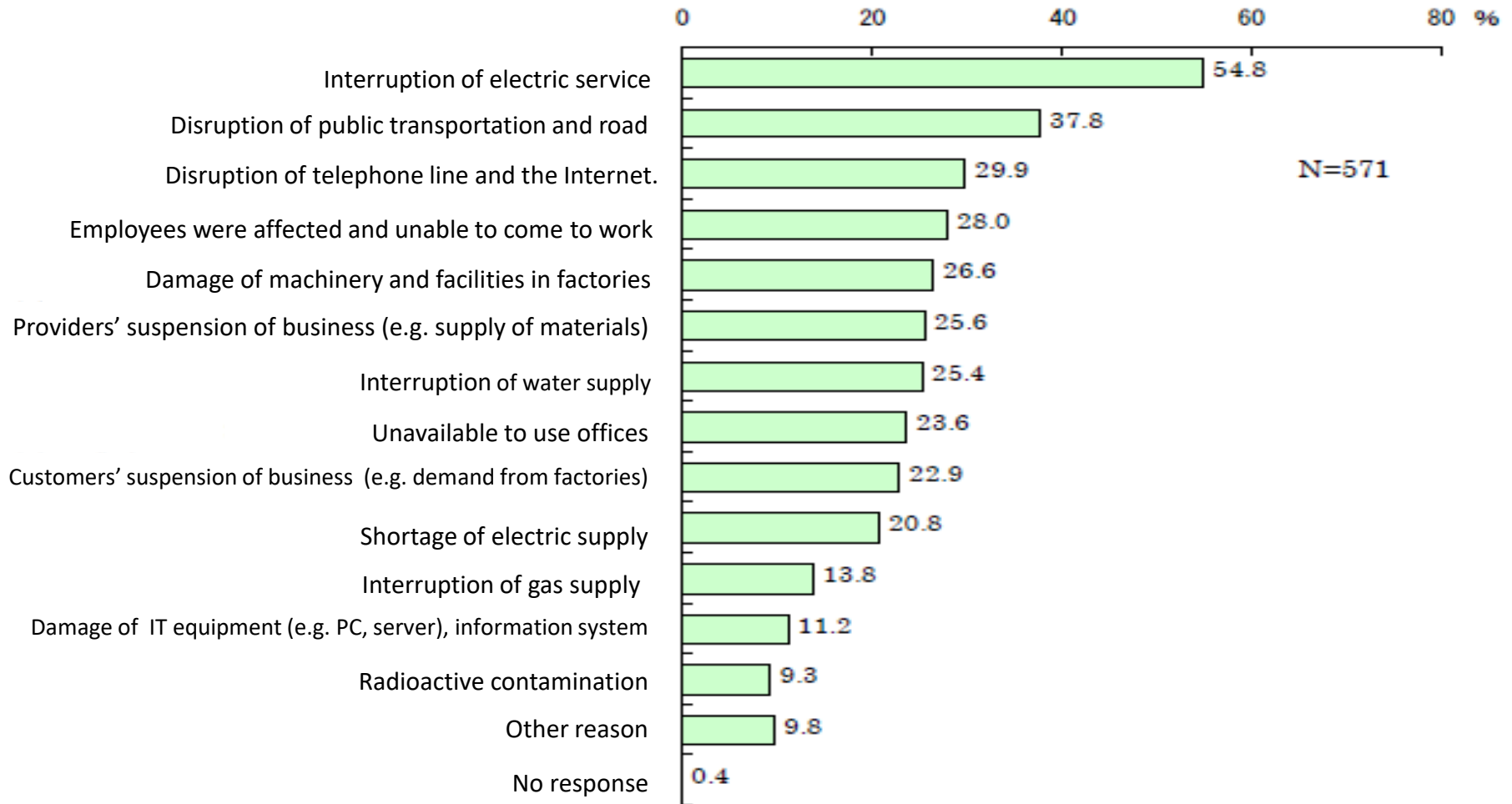


# Reasons of Suspension of Critical Operations in the Great East Japan Earthquake (As of November, 2011)
