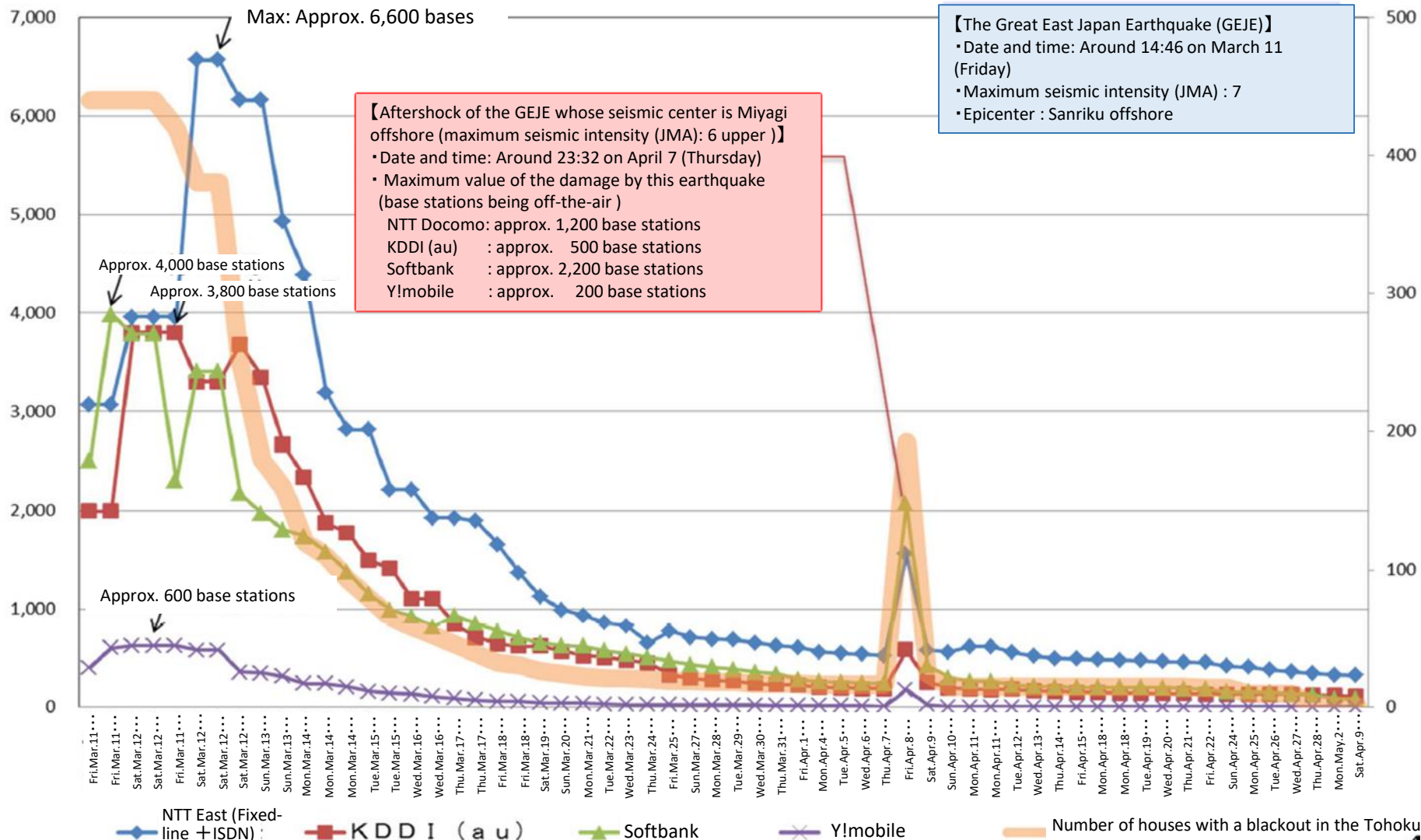


Number of Cell-Phone Base Station That Stopped Operations (By Telecommunications Carrier)
