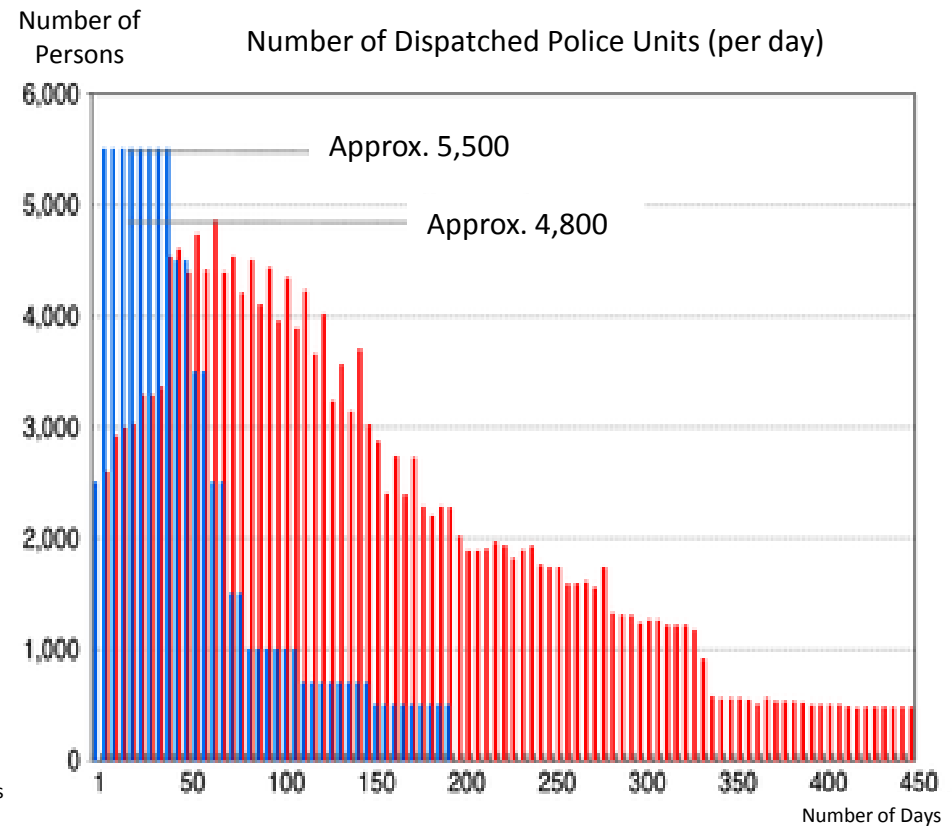
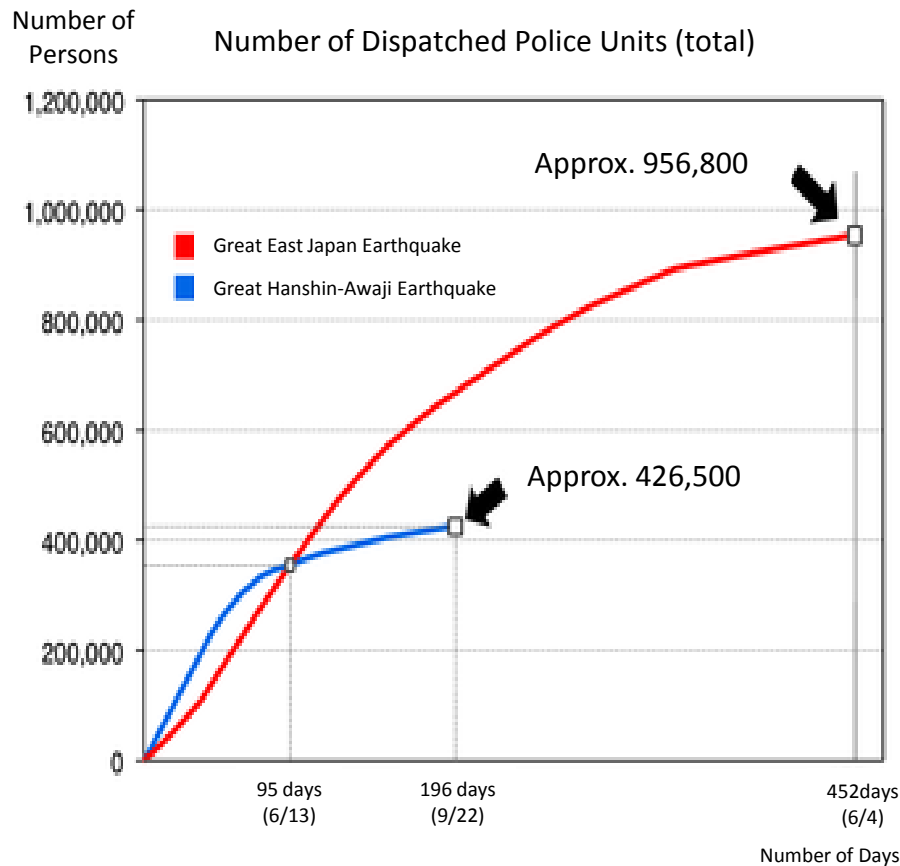


# Number of Dispatched Police Units During Great East Japan Earthquake and Great Hanshin-Awaji Earthquake ( Including Number of Persons Dispatched)
