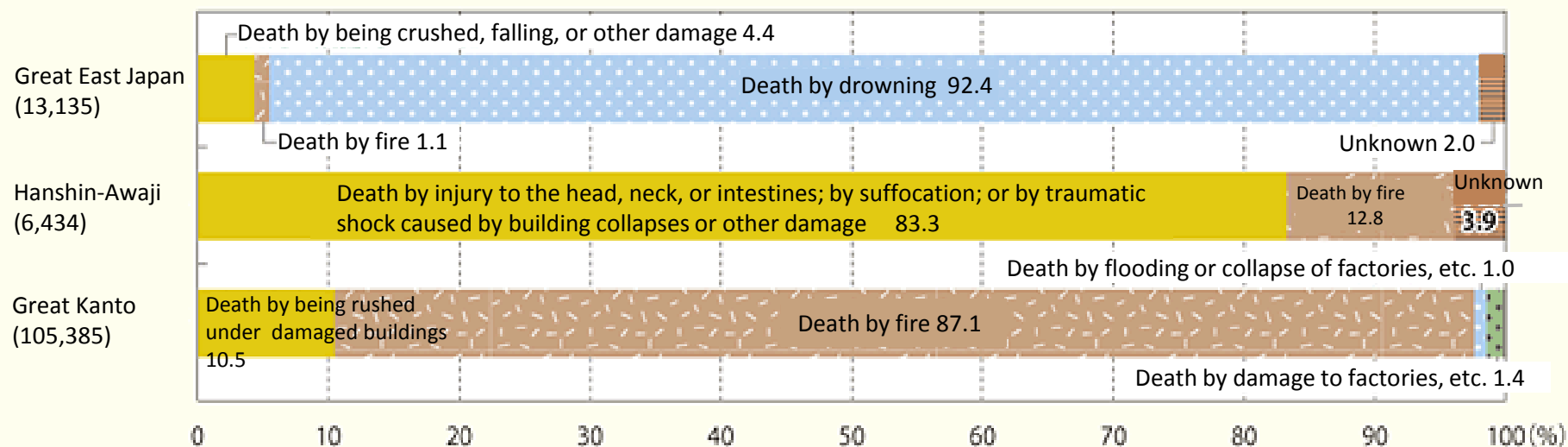


# Causes of Death in the Big Earthquakes
