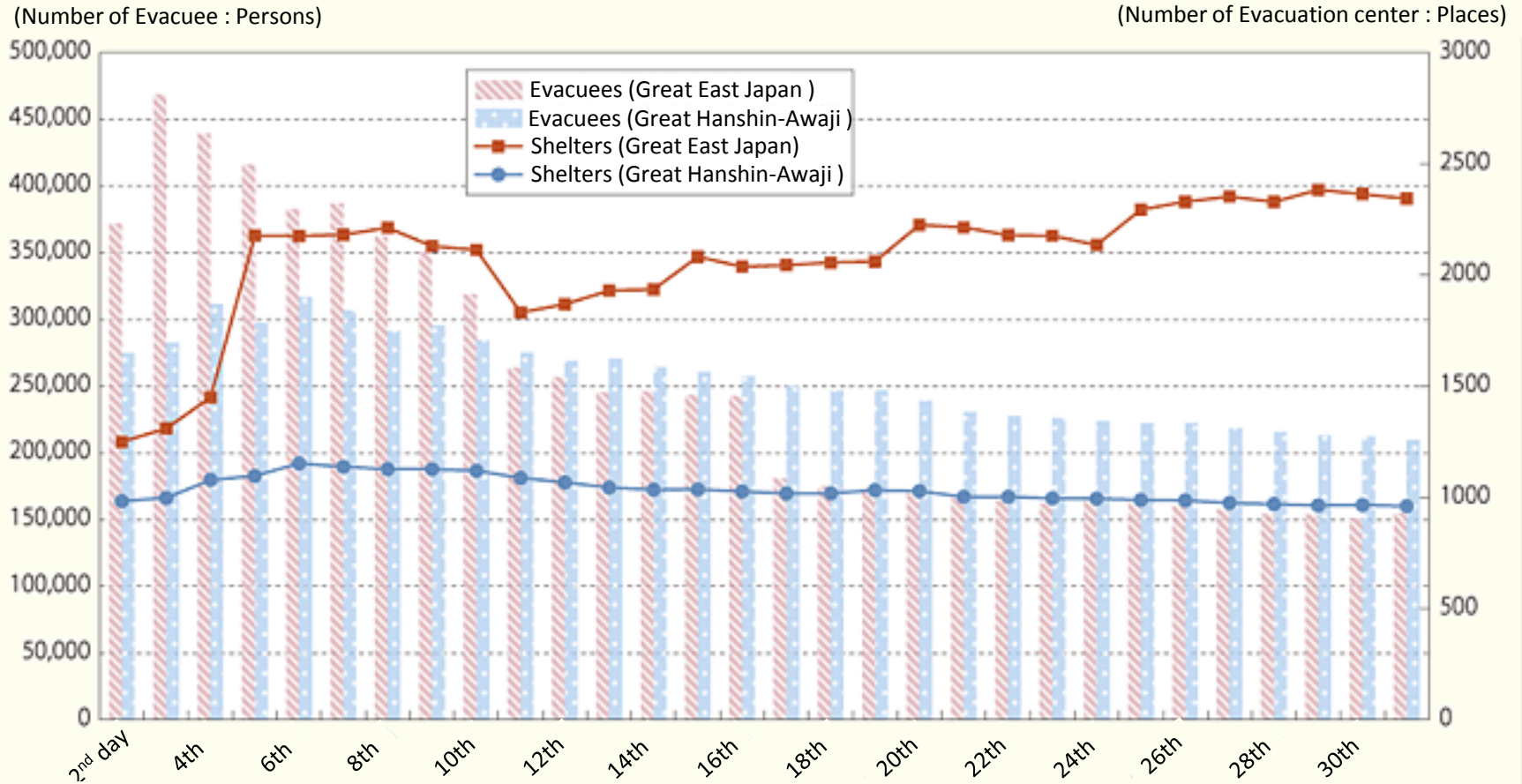


Trend of the Number of Evacuees in the Great East Japan Earthquake (Compared to the Great Hanshin-Awaji Earthquake)
