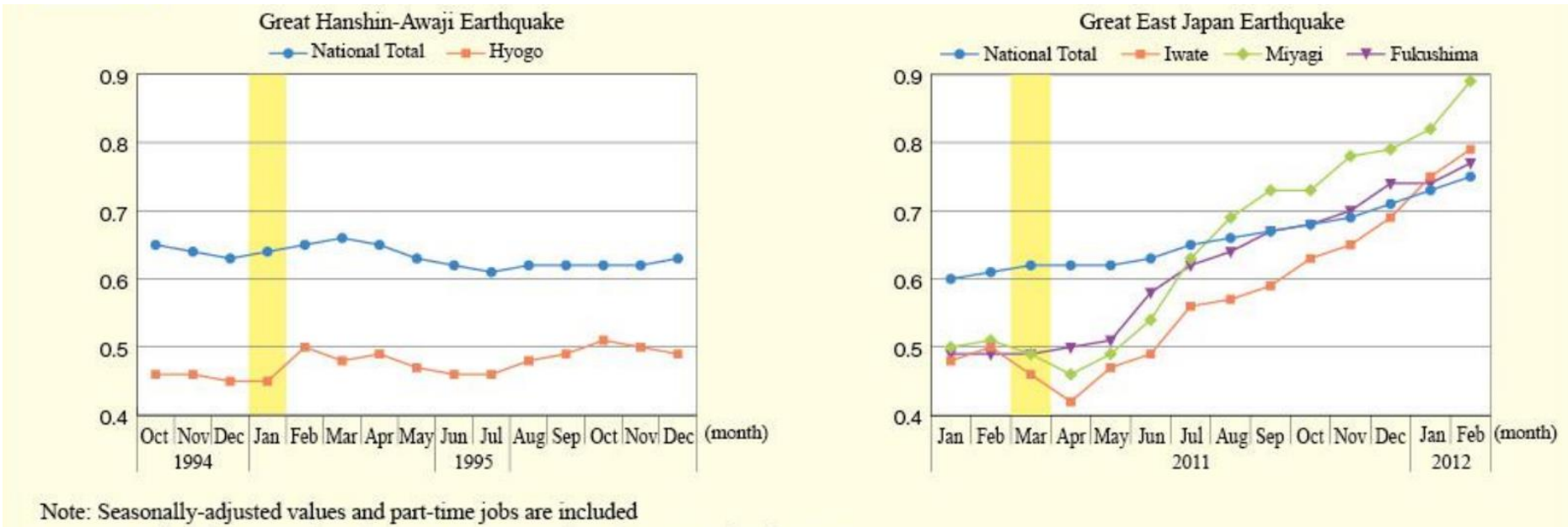


Change in the Ratio of Job Offers to Job Seekers (Great Hanshin-Awaji Earthquake, Great East Japan Earthquake)
