


Amount of Catches Landing by Prefecture in Three Affected Prefectures



- Note: 1. The value of the landings is equal to landing multiplied by price.
 2. The total for Iwate prefecture is calculated by adding the values from fishing ports of Miyako, Kamaishi, and Ofunato. That of Miyagi Prefecture is calculated by adding the values from fishing ports of Kesenuma, Onagawa, Ishinomaki, and Shiogama. That of Fukushima Prefecture is the value of Onahama Fishing port.
 3. Data is indicated until February, 2012, because year on year value increased sharply after March, 2012, in comparison with the average after the disaster.
